4. GSU Rep Update (Alyson)

o There was a meeting on Sept. 27, 2006. It was an introduction to the other GSU reps. There are soooo many departments it's unbelievable.

o There's a GSU listserve every Thursday that Emily will send out. Anyone can announce to the GSU listserve, but you have to send things in by Wednesday.

o The 'Grad Escapes' are social events the GSU organizes (opera, bolwing etc.) for under 20\$ (see the listserve for more info)

o The head count? Alyson tried talking to Charlotte and there doesn't seem to be anything to do about this so we can get all the money

o In February there's a campus wide student protest against university fee increases that we can take part. If interested get email from Alyson.

o Members at large could run for the position [sorry Alyson, what position is this?] and they get money (if you're interested tell Alyson)

o For the Ladies: Birth control is now in the health plan

o GSU and CUPE have dental. You can opt out of GSU by Oct. 6, and there's an opt-in for families on Oct. 6th.

o Head grant was submitted and there were no problems but we don't get the money until mid-October.

o Graydon asks what's the difference between two dental plans? Alyson replies that CUPE is more flexible (there are no restrictions).

o Mike says that CUPE is looking into a way for us to use CUPE money to pay for our GSU dental. He'll look into it.

5. Communications Coordinator (Amber)

o Goal this week was to get the website up. She was foiled by Chass. She requested for information about how to go about the website. The plan is twofold:

a) First, go to the office in person

b) Draft an email for Jenn and they'll take it to Janice who will present our needs to Chass for more clout.

6. Ink Situation (Emily and Jenn)

o We went through 1 toner cartridge in two weeks

o Printing is WAY up from last year and is not sustainable

o The printer was not meant to replace the home printer, and shouldn't

be used to print articles from reading lists.

o Options:

i. Collect a second Ink Fee in January

ii. Increase Ink Fees for next year

iii. Upper year students could pay the ink fee if they're using the printer

iv. An email needs to be sent out to tell everyone of the situation and to try and follow the guidelines - but no one wants to have a 'police' situation. Responses will be requested from the group

v. Where can we get cheaper toner cartridges? Costco? Any ideas? Please let the AGSU know (Best buy?). What about the university? Do they have a preferred supplier? Jenn will talk to Natalia about where the faculty gets their ink

7. Vis a Vis

• Andrew says some of the survey has been drafted to ask the faculty to get a feel for their awareness, the role they see it playing, recommend

their students to publish there?

o There is a long debate about what Vis a Vis should be, for who and it's feasibility and place on campus.

o Everyone agrees that Vis a Vis has a purpose, so we'll gage faculty interest is and then we can re-open this debate and hold ourselves to the time-line.

o The survey will be put in mailboxes etc., before Thanksgiving. The results will be organized and we can have some discussion.

8. Committees (Jenn)

o Graduate board and graduate committee meetings

o 2 large issues here:

1). there may be some restructuring of boards and committees this year and we have positions on committees but the tone seems to be that we'll be reorganizing them into a single board that has no graduate student reps and one board that will give recommendations to the other board. This has not been officially decided. An email has been sent out drafting our concerns about not being involved.

2). The dept. doesn't have a constitution so the process was never constitutionally amended to allow us on the boards so we can have a voice o the decision is being made on a committee that we've agreed to not sit in on so we don't know how this is going to work out. For now, there isn't much we can do.
